What's New this year ?

- The minimum eligibility criteria for engineering and technology courses has been relaxed to 35% for all candidates, except for those opting Architecture course.
- For admission to Architecture course, the candidates should compulsorily pass an Aptitude Test conducted by CET Cell.
- The Kannada Language test for Horanadu & Gadinadu Kannadiga candidates who claim eligibility for Government seats (Karnataka quota) will be held on 03-06-2003 at 10.30 a.m. in the CET Cell premises.
- There will be no separate seat selection process for SC, ST & 2A Category candidates for engineering / technology / architecture courses.
- There will be only one round of admission seat selection process, followed by a seat selection process for casual vacancies.
- After verification at CET Cell, all the original certificates have to be submitted by the candidates to the respective colleges while joining.
- The candidates are required to join the college well within the date prescribed in the admission orders, failing which the seat selected by such candidates will stand cancelled automatically.
- The candidates who join the college after obtaining admission order from CET Cell, will not be eligible for further rounds of seat selection process.
- The sons and daughters of N.R.I's and foreign nationals will not be eligible for Government seats.

1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

A candidate who has passed the second year Pre-University or XII standard or equivalent examination (herein after referred to as the "qualifying examination" or "Q.E." for short) with Physics and Mathematics alongwith Chemistry / Bio-Technology / Computer Science / Electronics / Information Science / Biology as optional subjects with English as one of the languages of study and obtained atleast 35% marks in the optional subjects is eligible for Engineering & Technology courses and 50% in case of Architecture course. (40% in case of SC/ST/Category-1 candidates for Architecture course.) Candidates who want to opt for Architecture course are required to pass an Aptitude Test also.

Since, the merit order / rank will be prepared based on the performance of the candidates in qualifying examination and Common Entrance Test, by considering the marks in equal proportions (PCM in case of Engineering / Technology / Architecture courses & PCB in case of Medical / Dental / Indian System of Medicine & Homoeopathy courses), the candidates claiming eligibility for Government seats should have studied CHEMISTRY as one of the optional subjects in the qualifying examination.

A candidate who has passed the Q.E. with Physics, Chemistry and Biology as optional subjects and English as one of the languages of study and obtained atleast 50% marks in the PCB group is eligible for Medical / Dental / Ayurveda / Homoeopathy / Unani / Naturopathy / Yoga courses, provided that for Dental course, the candidate must have secured 50% of marks in aggregate in optional subjects and English language. (40% in case of SC/ST/Category-1 candidates).

Further, the candidate seeking admission to Medical / Dental / Ayurveda / Homoeopathy / Unani / Naturopathy / Yoga courses should have completed the age of seventeen years as on 31st December of 2003.

A note on Horanadu Kannadiga & Gadinadu Kannadiga candidates

To determine the eligibility for Government seats by the Horanadu and Gadinadu Kannadiga candidates, the Kannada Language test will be held on 03-06-2003 at 10.30 a.m. in the CET Cell premises. No separate or individual intimation will be sent to the candidates regarding the date of conducting the Kannada Language test, which should be attended by the Horanadu and Gadinadu Kannadiga candidates at the CET Cell office on 03-06-2003 at 10.30 a.m., failing which the claim under this clause will not be considered.

2. ELIGIBILITY FOR GOVERNMENT SEATS (KARNATAKA QUOTA)

Candidates who satisfy one of the following conditions laid down under Rule - 5 qualify for admission to Government seats. Each condition is specified by a clause and is individually referred by a code. **The Clauses and codes are as follows :**

CLAUSES

CODES

The candidate should have studied and passed in one or more Government or Government recognised educational institutions located in the State of Karnataka for a minimum period of SEVEN academic years commencing from I standard to II PUC/12th standard as on 1st July of the year in which the Entrance Test is held and has appeared and passed SSLC/10th standard or II PUC/12th standard examination from Karnataka State. *In case of the candidate who had taken more than one year to pass a class or standard, the years of academic study is counted as one year only.*

a

The candidate should have studied and passed I and II year Pre-University Examination or equivalent examination within the State of Karnataka from an Educational Institution run or recognised by the State Government and that either of the parents should have studied in Karnataka for a minimum period of SEVEN years from 1st to 12th Std., which should be evident from the certificates issued by the concerned institution/s.

b

In the case of candidates whose mother tongue is Kannada, Tulu or Kodava and who are residing outside the State of Karnataka but within the territory of India as on 1st July of 2003, such candidates should have passed the qualifying examination from an University or Board or any other Institution located outside Karnataka. Provided also that the candidate shall undergo a test which shall be conducted by the CET Cell on 03-06-2003 at 10.30 a.m. to establish his ability to speak, read and write Kannada.

c

A candidate whose mother tongue is Kannada, Tulu or Kodava and who resides in disputed Kannada speaking area of South Sholapur or Akkalkot or Jath or Gadhinglaj Taluks of Maharashtra State or Kasargod Taluk of Kerala State. The candidate shall undergo a test which shall be conducted by the CET Cell on 03-06-2003 at 10.30 a.m. to establish his ability to speak, read and write Kannada.

d

In the case of a candidate who is son or daughter of defence personnel who has worked continuously in Karnataka as on any day, for a minimum period of one year from 1st July of 2002 to 30th June of 2003. The candidate should have studied and passed the qualifying examination from any Government or Government recognised educational institution located in Karnataka.

e

Son or daughter of serving defence personnel who at the time of joining the defence service had declared his/her home town a place in the State of Karnataka. Proof of such domicile should be obtained and produced by obtaining the extract from the Record Office of the Defence unit.

f

In the case of a candidate who is a son or daughter of a defence personnel who had served in Karnataka for at least one year and is posted on duty directly to the disturbed areas of Jammu and Kashmir or North-East and whose family is permitted by Defence Authorities to continue to stay in Karnataka. Such candidate should have studied and passed the qualifying examination from any Government or Government recognised educational institution located in Karnataka.

g

Son or daughter of an ex-servicemen who at the time of joining the defence service had declared a place in Karnataka as his home town, proof of such domicile should be obtained and produced from the "Deputy Director, Department of Sainik Welfare and Resettlement".

h

CLAUSES**CODES**

In the case of a candidate being a son or daughter of an employee of the Union Government or an employee of the Union or Karnataka State Government Undertaking or Joint Sector Undertaking, who is liable to be transferred anywhere in India as per the terms and conditions of his employment and has worked continuously for at least one year in Karnataka as on any day from 1st July of 2002 to 30th June of 2003 and such candidate has studied and passed the qualifying examination from any Government or Government recognised educational institutions located in Karnataka.

i

Son or daughter of a working or retired employee of the Union Government or employee of Union or Karnataka State Government undertaking or Joint Sector undertaking where such employee;

- (a) had declared to the employer at the time of joining service any place in Karnataka to be his home town; and
- (b) had studied in any Government or Government recognised educational institution or institutions located in Karnataka for not less than seven years at any time between 1st std. and 12th std., or Pre-University Examination; and
- (c) was or is liable to be transferred anywhere in India as per the terms and conditions of his employment.

j

Son or daughter of Members of Parliament elected from Karnataka.

k

Son or daughter of serving or retired employee :

- (a) belonging to All India Service of Karnataka cadre; and
- (b) of the Karnataka State Government,

who has served or is serving outside the State of Karnataka during the period corresponding to Candidate's study outside the State from 1st std. to II PUC or XII std. examination can be added to make up the seven year study within Karnataka as required under clause (a) above.

N.B. : Son or daughter in the various clauses of Item - 2 (Rule - 5) means only natural born son or daughter.

3. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO OUT SIDE KARNATAKA CANDIDATES

A candidate who does not satisfy any of the conditions laid down for Government seats (Karnataka quota) in Item - 2, will have the opportunity of selecting a seat under out side Karnataka quota. The out side Karnataka candidates will be assigned ranks without ascertaining their academic eligibility. Mere assigning of rank does not confer a right to select a seat. Candidates who have secured required minimum marks in the Qualifying Examination, as stipulated in Item - 1, are only eligible to participate in the seat selection process. **Candidates without academic eligibility need not attend the seat selection process.**

4. DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED DURING SEAT SELECTION PROCESS

The original documents to be produced during seat selection process have been detailed separately in respect of special category seats (Category wise), Government seats (clause wise) and out side Karnataka seats. They are as follows :

(A) Special Categories : Candidates claiming the benefit under special categories should produce the relevant original certificates mentioned against the respective categories along with two sets of photocopies on the dates given in the schedule at Page - 8 of this booklet, to the CET Cell in person during office hours. **The candidates should not send their special category documents / certificates through post or any other private arrangement.**

- (i) **NCC** : 'B' Certificate and other relevant certificates issued by the NCC authorities in support of the claim of the candidate.
- (ii) **Sports** : The certificates issued by the different federations in support of the claim of the candidate.
- (iii) **Scouts & Guides** : The President award Certificate.
- (iv) **Defence** :

Physically Disabled candidates should submit the medical certificate on the day of admission seat selection process i.e., on 10.07.2003 .	

- (a) Candidates claiming eligibility under Clause (e) of Item 2 of this booklet should produce the certificate of employment issued by the controlling office where the parent is working indicating the period during which the parent has worked in Karnataka.
- (b) Candidates claiming eligibility under Clause (f) of Item 2 of this booklet should produce a certificate from the record office of the Defence Unit indicating that the parent had declared a place in Karnataka as his home town at the time of joining the service.
- (c) Candidates claiming eligibility under Clause (g) of Item 2 of this booklet should produce a certificate from the controlling office indicating the period during which the parent has worked in Karnataka, the present place of posting and also the fact that his family is permitted to stay in Karnataka.
- (v) **Ex-Defence** : The certificate showing the home address of the parent issued by the Deputy Director, Department of Sainik Welfare and Resettlement.
- (vi) **Anglo-Indian** : The certificate issued by the Registered Association of the Anglo Indian Community in the State of Karnataka.
- (v) **Physically Disabled** : A medical certificate issued by the competent doctor of a Government Hospital in Karnataka in the field of the concerned disability should be produced. The candidates claiming reservation under this category will be required to appear on 10.07.2003 before a Committee comprising of the Special Officer, CET Cell as the Chairman and three specialists from the Department of Orthopedics, Ophthalmology and ENT, nominated by the Director of Medical Education, whose decision regarding the Physical disability shall be final.
- N. B.** : The candidates claiming under (iv) (a) and (c) should produce the study certificate issued by the head of the educational institution for having studied and passed the qualifying examination in Karnataka when they come for the admission seat selection process.

(B) Karnataka Quota : Candidates who seek admission to Government seats (Karnataka quota) will have to produce the original documents with **TWO** sets of attested photocopies along with 2 passport size photographs, when they come for seat selection process.

After the verification, the candidates should collect back all the original documents and should submit the same to the respective colleges along with the admission order issued by CET Cell, while joining the college. **The candidates should invariably report to the colleges well within the date prescribed in the admission order, failing which the seat selected by the candidates will stand cancelled automatically.**

For the benefit of candidates, the documents to be produced are detailed clause wise. Some of the prominent documents are detailed below :

- SSLC Marks Card** : SSLC Marks Card or X standard or equivalent examination marks card for proof of date of birth.
- II PUC Marks Card** : II PUC or XII standard or qualifying examination marks card.
- Study Certificate** : Study Certificate to show that the candidate has studied in Karnataka for a minimum period of SEVEN years from 1st Std. to 12th Std. or qualifying examination issued by the Head of the institution and countersigned by the BEO or DDPI in the proforma prescribed at Page - 11.
- Rural Study Certificate** : Rural Study Certificate in respect of candidates claiming the benefit of rural reservation should produce a verification certificate from the concerned Tasildar alongwith a rural study certificate for having studied 10 full academic years from 1st Std. to 10th Std. in the state of Karnataka issued by the Head of the educational institution and such certificate should be got countersigned by the BEO or DDPI in the proforma prescribed at Page - 11.
- Note : The candidates whose parents come under creamy layer are not eligible to claim the benefit of rural reservation.
- Kannada Medium Study Certificate** : Kannada Medium Study Certificate in respect of candidates claiming the benefit of Kannada Medium reservation should produce the certificate for having studied 10 full academic years in Kannada medium from 1st Std. to 10th Std. in any educational institutions located in Karnataka run or recognised by the Government of Karnataka, issued by the Head of the educational institution and such certificate should be got countersigned by the BEO or DDPI in the proforma prescribed at Page - 11.
- Caste / Caste Income Certificate** : The candidates seeking reservation benefit should produce a **Caste Certificate** in form 'D' in case of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and in form 'E' in case of Category-I and a **Caste Income Certificate** in form 'F' for other backward classes like 2A, 2B, 3A and 3B, issued by the concerned Jurisdictional Tahasildar, in accordance with the Government order No. Sa Ka E 25 BCA 2002 dated 23rd March 2002, as amended from time to time.

Please Note that the study certificates of both candidates & parents, as the case may be, should be got countersigned invariably by the BEO / DDPI alongwith the Address, Seal & Telephone Number of the concerned office.

THE ELIGIBILITY CLAUSES FOR GOVERNMENT SEATS (KARNATAKA QUOTA) ARE DETAILED IN ITEM-2 OF THIS BOOKLET. THE CANDIDATES HAVE TO PRODUCE ALL RELEVANT DOCUMENTS IN SUPPORT OF THE CLAUSE CLAIMED BY THEM. THE DETAILS ARE AS FOLLOWS :

- Clause - a** : SSLC Marks Card, II PUC Marks Card, Study Certificate and Rural Study Certificate, Kannada Medium Study Certificate, Caste / Caste Income Certificate, if applicable.
- Clause - b** : SSLC Marks Card, II PUC Marks Card, Study Certificate and Caste / Caste Income Certificate if applicable, alongwith
- 1) a certificate for either of the parent having studied for at least 7 years in Karnataka from 1st Std. to 12th Std. from the Head of the educational institution where he/she had studied.
 - 2) the candidate's study certificate for having studied I and II PUC or equivalent examination in Karnataka issued by the head of the educational institution.
- Clause - c** : SSLC Marks Card & II PUC Marks Card, alongwith
- 1) a domicile certificate of the candidate for having resided outside the state of Karnataka but within the territory of India as on 01.07.2003 issued by concerned Revenue or Municipal Authorities.
 - 2) a certificate issued by concerned Revenue Authorities of the state of Karnataka regarding the previous domicile of the parents in the state of Karnataka.
 - 3) either of the parents 10th std. marks card, original cumulative record, candidate's Transfer Certificate or any other documentary proof in original in support of mother tongue.

The photocopies of all the above documents pertaining to this clause should be produced at the time of Kannada Language Test and the same will not be accepted at a later date and time.

- Clause - d** : SSLC Marks Card & II PUC Marks Card, alongwith
 1) a present residential certificate from the concerned Tahsildar of the respective Taluk.
 2) either of the parents 10th std. marks card, original cumulative record or any other documentary proof in original in support of mother tongue.
The photocopies of all the above documents pertaining to this clause should be produced at the time of Kannada Language Test and the same will not be accepted at a later date and time.
- Clause - e** : SSLC Marks Card & II PUC Marks Card, alongwith
 1) the candidate's study certificate for having studied II PUC or equivalent examination in Karnataka issued by the head of the educational institution.
 2) employment certificate of the parent issued by the controlling office where the parent is working indicating the period during which he has worked in Karnataka.
- Clause - f** : SSLC Marks Card, II PUC Marks Card and Caste / Caste Income Certificate if applicable, alongwith parent's home town declaration certificate while joining the service issued by record office of the defence unit.
- Clause - g** : SSLC Marks Card & II PUC Marks Card, alongwith
 1) the candidate's study certificate for having studied II PUC or equivalent examination in Karnataka issued by the head of the educational institution.
 2) service certificate of the parent issued by the controlling office indicating the period during which the parent has worked in Karnataka and a certificate showing the present place of posting, indicating that his family is permitted to stay in Karnataka.
- Clause - h** : SSLC Marks Card, II PUC Marks Card and Caste / Caste Income Certificate if applicable, alongwith the parent's home town declaration certificate while joining the service issued by the Deputy Director, Department of Sainik Welfare and Resettlement.
- Clause - i** : SSLC Marks Card & II PUC Marks Card, alongwith
 1) the candidate's study certificate for having studied II PUC or equivalent examination in Karnataka issued by the head of the educational institution.
 2) a certificate from the employer indicating the parent's period of employment in Karnataka and also showing that he is transferable anywhere in India.
- Clause - j** : SSLC Marks Card, II PUC Marks Card and Caste / Caste Income Certificate if applicable, alongwith
 1) a certificate of the parent employee for having studied for at least 7 years in Karnataka between 1st Std. and XII Std. from the Head of the educational institution.
 2) home town declaration certificate of the parent employee while joining the service, showing that he is transferable anywhere in India issued by the employer.
- Clause - k** : SSLC Marks Card, II PUC Marks Card and Caste / Caste Income Certificate if applicable, alongwith a certificate showing that the parent is / was a Member of Parliament elected from Karnataka issued by the Parliament Secretariat.
- Clause - l** : SSLC Marks Card, II PUC Marks Card and Caste / Caste Income Certificate if applicable, alongwith a certificate from the Secretary, DPAR, Government of Karnataka, Bangalore where the parent belongs to All India Service of Karnataka cadre stating that the parent is a member of such All India Cadre. The certificate should also indicate the period during which he has served or is serving outside the state of Karnataka and if the parent is a State Government Employee, a certificate from the concerned Head of the Department or the Head of the Office where such parent is employed should be produced in this regard.

N.B.: Where the eligibility of the candidate is based on the study, employment, etc., of the parent, documents to establish the relationship of the candidate with the parent has to be produced.

(C) Outside Karnataka Quota : Candidates who seek admission under outside Karnataka quota will have to produce the following original documents with **TWO** sets of attested photocopies along with 2 passport size photographs, when they come for seat selection process.

After the verification, the candidates should collect back all the original documents and should submit the same to the respective colleges along with the admission order issued by CET Cell, while joining the college. The candidates should invariably report to the colleges well within the date prescribed in the admission order, failing which the seat selected by the candidates will stand cancelled automatically.

- (a) SSLC or 10th standard or equivalent marks card for proof of date of birth.
 (b) II PUC or 12th standard or qualifying examination marks card.

N.B. : The contents of the documents submitted by the candidates should be either in Kannada or English language. If the documents are in any other official language, the same should be got translated to Kannada or English language through the concerned authorities with signature & seal and should be produced. Otherwise the CET Cell reserves the right to reject the same.

5. FEE STRUCTURE

The fee structure for the Medical, Dental, Indian System of Medicine & Homoeopathy and Engineering courses will be made known separately on the notice board of the CET Cell before 09-07-2003 and the same will also be made available on the CET Cell website <http://kar.nic.in/cet> for information of the candidates and parents.

The fees notified should be paid by the candidates when they come for seat selection process, in the form of a Demand Draft drawn in favour of "The Special Officer, CET Cell, Bangalore", payable at Bangalore. In case of revision of fees by the Government, the additional fee if any, has to be remitted in the college concerned and refund if any, has to be claimed in the college concerned.

6. SHARING OF SEATS BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT AND THE COLLEGE MANagements

The CET Cell will come to know about the exact number of seats, their classification and categories just before the admission process starts. Hence, an accurate picture about availability of seats, collegewise, categorywise and coursewise, can not be brought out at this stage. For the benefit of the candidates, full postal addresses and telephone numbers of the professional colleges as furnished by the respective colleges, are given in **Appendix - I** at Page - 17.

The Probable number of seats for Medical, Dental and Engineering disciplines (college wise) have also been furnished in **Appendix - III** at Page - 27.

Instructions for preservation of replica of 'CET 2003' OMR answer sheets

The candidates who desire to opt for a seat through CET Cell should carry the replicas of 'CET 2003' OMR answer sheets to the CET Cell on the date of their seat selection process. If the seat is selected by the candidate and the admission order is obtained from the CET Cell, such candidates should invariably preserve all the 'CET 2003' OMR answer sheet replicas for a minimum period of one year from the date of obtaining the admission order, as complaints if any received shall be investigated and action taken. (Please refer box item in Page - 17 of the brochure issued along with 'CET 2003' application form.)

7. STAGES OF SELECTION OF SEATS BY THE CANDIDATES

Selection of a seat by a candidate and admission thereafter at the CET Cell involves the following stages:

- (a) Registration of the candidate
- (b) Verification of the original documents
- (c) Exercising the option by the candidate
- (d) Remittance of Fees in the form of a Demand Draft and
- (e) Issue of Admission Order

The said activities have been divided into **an Admission seat selection followed by a Casual Vacancy seat selection process**. Most of the candidates would have secured ranks in both the disciplines. Having selected a seat in medial / dental / Indian system of medicine & homoeopathy, a candidate may change his mind and opt for an engineering / technology / architecture seat. This leads to a medical / dental / Indian system of medicine & homoeopathy seat falling vacant and vice-versa is also true. In order to take care of such problems, flexibility has been built into the system by dividing the entire process into one Admission round followed by a Casual Vacancy round.

In both the rounds the candidates will be allowed to exercise the option and to select a seat of their choice strictly in the order of their merit.

A day is divided into four sessions and the first session begins at 8.00 am. The candidates are required to register themselves in the first counter where their CET number is entered into the computer system. From there, the candidates are sent to the Verification Counter where the entries of original documents are checked against the particulars that would have been furnished by them in their application forms. After verification, only the attested photo copies will be retained by the CET Cell and the original documents will be returned to the candidates for depositing the same to the concerned colleges.

The entire activities in the CET Cell is controlled by a powerful computer system from the stage of registration till the stage of printing of admission orders. The highly sophisticated software used in the system has the ability on one side to control the initial registration, provide data for verification of the original documents and on the other side to take care of the selection of seats by the candidates in the order of their merit, payment of fees and finally printing of admission orders. As already said once the candidate comes to the Admission Hall, the computer will not allow a candidate to jump the order of merit. Even if one had registered himself before another candidate with a better merit he will have to wait for his turn at the admission terminals. Unless a candidate who has better rank and whose CET number is registered gets the opportunity to select a seat, a candidate who has a rank next to him cannot think of by-passing him. The computer will not allow such a thing. Normally a candidate gets 3 to 5 minutes to decide his option. He has the assistance of a huge on-line projector screen, which will show category-wise, course-wise and college-wise availability of seats at that moment. The moment he exercises his option the projector screen will show one seat less against the college from which the candidate has selected the seat.

From the display terminals, the candidate will have to go to the Bank counter and deposit the fee in the form of demand draft. The Bank Officer can enter the amount only if the candidate has selected a seat, otherwise the terminal will not allow him to do so. Once the amount is properly entered against the name of the candidate, a printer automatically prints the admission order at the other end.

Normally the candidates will have to spend 15 minutes at the documents verification counter and then if his rank is good within the next few minutes he will get an opportunity to select a seat. If his rank is in the end, then perhaps, he will have to wait till the end of the session, to collect his admission order.

8. EXERCISING OF OPTION BY THE CANDIDATES AND ADMISSION

Every year, the seat selection process was held in two rounds namely Preliminary round and Admission round followed by a casual vacancy round. In accordance with new admission rules, the seat selection process is constrained to one admission round followed by a casual vacancy round.

ADMISSION SEAT SELECTION PROCESS

A) FOR PHYSICALLY DISABLED, NCC AND SPORTS SPECIAL CATEGORIES.

The Engineering, Technology, Architecture, Medical, Dental, Indian System of Medicine and Homoeopathy seats reserved in respect of Physically disabled, NCC and Sports special categories will be offered in the first instance to all eligible candidates as per the schedule given in **Appendix - II** at Page - 24.

The candidates who select a special category seat should report to the respective colleges well within the date prescribed in the admission order. Such candidates who report to the colleges will not be eligible for any of the further rounds. The candidates who do not join the respective colleges after obtaining an admission order in respect of a special category seat, are eligible to participate in the further rounds.

B) FOR MEDICAL, DENTAL, INDIAN SYSTEM OF MEDICINE AND HOMOEOPATHY COURSES.

All eligible candidates including the candidates who have not joined the respective colleges after selecting a special category seat will be eligible for participating in the admission seat selection process of Medical, Dental, Indian System of Medicine and Homoeopathy seats. The candidates will be allowed to select a Medical, Dental, Indian System of Medicine and Homoeopathy seat of their choice, in the order of merit.

The special category candidates who select a seat in this round will have to surrender the special category seat selected in the previous round. After selecting a seat, the candidates should pay the prescribed fee in the form of Demand Draft and should obtain the admission order. Thereafter, the candidates should report to the respective colleges along with all original documents and the admission order issued by CET Cell, well within the date prescribed in the admission order. The candidates who report to the respective colleges will not be eligible for any of the further rounds of seat selection process. The candidates who do not join the respective colleges after obtaining an admission order in respect of Medical, Dental, Indian System of Medicine and Homoeopathy seat, are eligible to participate in the Engineering / Technology / Architecture seat selection process.

C) FOR ENGINEERING / TECHNOLOGY / ARCHITECTURE COURSES

Every year, the Engineering seat selection process was held in the first instance for SC, ST & 2A category candidates. This year, the Engineering / Technology / Architecture seat selection process will be held simultaneously for all categories; wherein, the general merit and reserved category merit seats will be offered alongwith higher payment seats, to all eligible candidates at once. In the process, the candidates belonging to reserved categories will have the opportunity of selecting a seat under general merit category also.

The candidates who have not selected any seat and the candidates who have not reported to the respective colleges after selecting a seat in the previous rounds are eligible to participate in the Engineering / Technology / Architecture seat selection process. The candidates who select a seat in this round will have to surrender the seat selected in the previous round, if any.

After selecting a seat, the candidates should pay the prescribed fee in the form of Demand Draft and should obtain the admission order. Thereafter, the candidates should report to the respective colleges along with all original documents and the admission order issued by CET Cell, well within the date prescribed in the admission order. The candidates who report to the respective colleges will not be eligible for casual vacancy seat selection process. The candidates who do not join the respective colleges after obtaining an admission order in respect of Engineering / Technology / Architecture seat, are eligible to participate in the casual vacancy seat selection process.

In the Admission seat selection process, all the Government seats pertaining to Karnataka quota candidates will be offered in the first instance. Thereafter, the Medical / Dental and Engineering / Technology / Architecture seats pertaining to outside Karnataka quota candidates will be offered in accordance with the schedule given in **Appendix - II** at Page - 24.

Note : Due to non availability of seats, the Indian System of Medicine and Homoeopathy courses will not be offered to Outside Karnataka candidates.

CASUAL VACANCY SEAT SELECTION PROCESS

After the completion of admission seat selection process, the surrendered / forfeited seats and the not reported cancelled seats will be offered as "Casual Vacancies". The candidates who have not selected any seat in the admission seat selection process and the candidates who have not joined the respective colleges after obtaining an admission order in respect of a Medical / Dental / Indian System of Medicine & Homoeopathy / Engineering / Technology / Architecture seat, in the admission seat selection process are only eligible for participating in the Casual vacancy seat selection process.

All the Casual vacancies will be offered alongwith the unfilled seats, if any, to eligible candidates in accordance with the schedule given in **Appendix - II** at Page - 24. The candidates who select a casual vacancy seat should invariably report to the respective colleges without waiting for any of the further rounds, along with all original documents and the admission order issued by CET Cell, well within the date prescribed in the admission order.

The candidates who select a special category / reserved category seat in this round will not be eligible for the General merit and higher payment seats.

CONVERSION PROCEDURE OF RESERVED CATEGORY SEATS IN THE CASUAL VACANCY SEAT SELECTION PROCESS.

In the first instance, the casual vacancies of Physically disabled, N.C.C. and Sports special categories will be offered to the eligible candidates. Then, the merit seats pertaining to SCR, SCK, STR, STK, 1R, 1K, 2AR, 2AK, 2BR, 2BK, 3AR, 3AK, 3BR, 3BK, GMR and GMK categories will be offered to the respective reserved category candidates. Thereafter, all the unfilled rural and Kannada medium merit seats of the reserved categories will be merged with General seats of the respective reserved categories and offered to the candidates belonging to SCG, STG, 1G, 2AG, 2BG, 3AG and 3BG categories. In the end, the unfilled general seats of all the reserved categories alongwith the unfilled seats of all the special categories will be merged with the General Merit seats and will be offered to the eligible candidates alongwith higher payment seats. This procedure of conversion will be followed in respect of both Medical, Dental, Indian System of Medicine & Homoeopathy and Engineering, Technology & Architecture seat selection process, for Karnataka quota candidates.

The Casual vacancy seat selection process for Karnataka quota candidates will be held in the first instance for Medical / Dental / Indian System of Medicine & Homoeopathy courses followed by Engineering / Technology / Architecture courses. After the completion of Karnataka quota seat selection process, the Medical / Dental and Engineering casual vacancies pertaining to outside Karnataka quota will be held as per the schedule given in **Appendix - II** at Page - 24.

The issue of admission order by the CET Cell shall enable the candidate to join the concerned college subject to the eligibility being approved by the concerned University as per the regulations.

REFUND AND FORFEITURE OF FEE

- (1) If the candidate who has selected a seat in the seat selection process surrenders the seat by returning the original admission order to the CET Cell under proper acknowledgement after the completion of the admission seat selection process for Medical / Dental / Indian System of Medicine & Homoeopathy / Engineering / Technology / Architecture courses, but before the first day of commencement of casual vacancy seat selection process, the Special Officer shall forfeit to the CET Cell, fifty percent of the amount paid as fees and refund the remaining amount to the candidate.
- (2) If a candidate who has received an admission order does not surrender, cancel or fails to join the college / course allotted, before the commencement of the casual vacancy seat selection process, the Special Officer shall forfeit the entire amount paid as fees by the concerned candidate.
- (3) After the last date fixed for the candidates to join the institutions to which they are admitted, the Principal of the respective institutions shall send list of candidates who have joined the course to the Special Officer within two days from there, i.e., the last date for admission prescribed in the admission order.
- (4) A candidate who selects a casual vacancy seat and does not join the college concerned shall not be entitled for refund of deposited fees.
- (5) The fee deposited in the casual vacancy round, upon seat being selected by the candidate in the casual vacancy round, shall not be liable to be refunded to the candidate, in case of cancellation of the selected seat by the candidate or refusal to take admission order or failing to produce the admission order and / or join the college concerned within the stipulated date mentioned in the admission order.
- (6) If a candidate who has received admission order from the Special Officer, CET Cell and has joined the college, thereafter discontinues, on or before the last date stipulated by the concerned University, the entire fee paid by the candidate in the CET Cell shall be forfeited by the Special Officer, CET Cell.

9. CHANGE OF COLLEGE OR COURSE OR MUTUAL EXCHANGE

The CET Cell does not entertain requests for change of course or college at any stage as sufficient flexibility has been built into the seat selection process. Moreover, such a thing will lead to confusion and complications. However, after the completion of entire admission process, the candidates can approach the Director of Technical Education (Ph: 080 - 2266184) and Director of Medical Education (Ph: 080 - 2870060) as the case may be, who may entertain such requests for mutual exchanges. The candidates who opt for mutual exchange will not be eligible for participating in any of the further rounds of seat selection process.

LEGAL JURISDICTION

Any dispute that may arise in respect of the test or the later seat selection and admission is subject to the jurisdiction of the courts within the city of Bangalore and the Hon'ble High court of Karnataka.
