**ADMISSION TO B.Sc (HONOURS) ECONOMICS FOR THE
YEAR 2017-18**

- 1) Applications are invited from eligible candidates of India including the wards of Jammu & Kashmiri Migrants for registration to the Entrance Test-2017 to 1st Year B.Sc (Honours) Economics detailed herein for 50 seats for the academic year 2017-18 in Bengaluru Dr. B.R. Ambedkar School of Economics (autonomous institution of Government of Karnataka), No.32, D. Devaraj Urs Road (Opposite Race Course), Bengaluru, Karnataka 560 001, (phone 080-22355141 Fax 080-2225347 e-mail basekarnataka@gmail.com). The course will be residential one. 50% seats are reserved for students of Karnataka and remaining 50% seats are reserved for students of all States of the country including Karnataka. Entrance exam will be conducted in all the four Revenue Divisional headquarters viz., Bengaluru, Mysuru, Belagavi and Kalaburgi within Karnataka State, and at Pune, Kolkata, Delhi and Chennai Cities.
- 2) Academic Eligibility: No candidate shall be eligible for admission to Bengaluru Dr. B.R. Ambedkar School of Economics unless he is a citizen of

India and satisfies any one of the eligibility conditions hosted KEA website <http://kea.kar.nic.in>. The candidates who do not satisfy any of the clauses/eligibility criteria are not eligible for admission to BASE.

NOTE: The Candidates have to compulsorily appear for Common Entrance Test-2017 (hereinafter referred as CET-2017) for admission to the course mentioned.

Those who have already appeared for CUCET based on notification, are also required to appear for the exam of this School

	Eligibility
Admission for 50 seats for 1 st year B.Sc (Honours) Economics (3 years course)	In qualifying examination, candidate should have Passed in 2 nd PUC/12 th Standard/Equivalent Exam with English as one of the Languages and Mathematics as core subject and obtained a Minimum of 65% of marks in aggregate (60% for SC, ST). Reservation will be as decided by Government of Karnataka

3) How to apply

Step:1	Enter all the details through ONLINE by browsing URL on website http://kea.kar.nic.in by selecting CET-2017 UG Online Application. After completion of entry of all the details, candidates will receive an application ID and Password to their registered mobile phone number and to email address and also the same information will be displayed on the screen
Step: 2	Upload the scanned copy of the recent passport size Colour Photograph. Signature and Left Hand Thumb Impression in JPG/JPEG format separately

Step: 3	Print the Challan copy which is in triplicate. In the Challan, the details of the candidate will be pre-printed, such as Name, CET Number, College/Course, Fee to be paid Bank Account Number. All Candidates have to pay an amount of Rs.500/- General Category and Rs.300 for SC/ST Category. The candidates have to pay the requisite fee at e-Post Office/in any of the branch of the nationalized Bank. The bank/e-post office will retain bank/post office copy of the Challan with them and handover the remaining two copies of the Challan to the candidates. the candidates who are residing outside India shall pay the fees in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of Executive Director, Karnataka Examinations Authority, payable at Bengaluru, the Demand draft should be sent to KEA address by mentioning the application number
Step: 4	Take a printout of the application form on A-4 size paper.

Note: Candidates should note down their application ID and Password until the completion of filling up of the online application. Candidate has to enter all the required details in the form, failing which their application will not be considered. Candidates are not allowed to edit their application after selecting declaration/taking the final printout.

The candidate who fails to upload the Photo/Signature/LTM or who fails to pay the fees within the prescribed date and time, such candidate's application form will not be considered as valid and they will not be eligible for further process.

The information/particulars furnished by the candidates in their CET-2017 online application form will be deemed as 'Final' and be the basis for further process. The information furnished in the CET-2017 online application form with regard to Caste/Category and Annual Income remains the same for the purpose of assignment of ranks/selection or allotment of a seat and no change will be entertained in future for any reason.

- 4) Seat allotment will be done Online in the order of merit/rank obtained in CET-2017 as applicable.
- 5) Verification of documents will be done only at Karnataka Examination Authority, Sampige Road, 18th Cross, Malleswaram, Bengaluru 560 012

after declaration of results/publication of merit list. Only upon verification of documents, verification slip will be issued for admission. Every candidate shall be given high security user ID and Secret Key which the candidate then has to login and change it to password as per his/her choice.

COMMON ENTRANCE TEST-2017 CONTENT

Question papers will be bilingual i.e., Kannada and English, except the test of English language.

Syllabus for the Objective Type Exam

I. Test of Reasoning

This test would include questions of both verbal and non-verbal type. The test may include questions and analogies, similarities, differences, space visualization, problem-solving, analysis, judgment, decision, making visual memory discrimination, observation, relationship concepts, arithmetical reasoning, verbal and figure classification, arithmetical number series etc. The test will also include questions designed to test the candidate's abilities to deal with abstract ideas and symbols and their relationships, arithmetical computation and other analytical functions.

II. Test of English Language

English language ability would be treated through questions on grammar, vocabulary, sentence completion, synonyms, antonyms, comprehension of a passage, logical inferences etc.

III. Test of Numerical Ability

Questions will be designed to test the ability of arithmetical computation of whole numbers, decimals and fractions and relationship between numbers. The question would be based on arithmetical concepts and relationship between numbers and not on complicated arithmetical compensation.

IV. General knowledge and Current Affairs

The General knowledge will be tested on general awareness including static general knowledge. Questions on Current affairs will test candidates on their knowledge of national and international Current affairs.

Objective type of exam will consist of test of reasoning, test of quantitative aptitude test, test of English, test of General Knowledge and Current affairs.

Duration of test will be 120 minutes.

It is a multiple choice-based entrance exam consisting of 100 questions of 1 mark each with negative marking of $\frac{1}{4}^{\text{th}}$ of marks for each wrong answer.

Scholarship will be provided to meritorious and deserving candidates. Discretion of the School shall be final in this regard.
