### PGCET-2018

#### A. Important Instructions to Candidates - On the days of examination:

1. OMR Answer Sheet is a **candidate specific**.
2. OMR Answer Sheet which will be given to the candidates in the examination hall will be pre-printed with the candidate **Admission Ticket Number (PGCET No.)**, **Name** and **Subject**, hence the candidates have to confirm whether the **PGCET No.**, **Name** printed on the OMR Answer Sheet and in the Admission Ticket are same.
3. Candidates have to enter and shade the Version Code on the OMR Answer Sheet without making any mistakes.
4. Candidates have to compulsorily affix the complete signature and Left Hand Thumb Impression at the bottom portion of the OMR answer sheet in the space provided.

- ✓ The PGCET-2018 will be held in one session separately for **MBA**, conducted for 100 marks with 150 minutes duration. There will be **100** questions and each question will carry ONE mark.
- ✓ The PGCET-2018 will be held in one session separately for **MCA** courses conducted for **100** marks with 150 minutes duration. **60** questions in Part - A carry one mark each. **20** questions in Part - B carry two marks each. Thus there will be 80 questions and a total mark is 100.
- ✓ The PGCET-2018 will be held in two sessions separately for **Type – A and Type-B of ME / M.Tech / M.Arch.** courses conducted 100 marks with 150 minutes duration. Total Number of Questions: **75**
- ✓ OMR Answer Sheet is common for all the subjects / courses. Candidate has to mark the answers against the questions as per the questions printed in the question paper for respective subjects.

#### B. General Instructions:

1. Use of any calculator or log table etc is prohibited.
2. There are no negative marks for incorrect answers.
3. The eligible candidates have to compulsorily appear for the Examination as per the schedule to become eligible for further process of admission. The names of the candidate will not be included Merit list and will not be considered for further admission process who fails to appear for the examination.
4. Mere appearing for Examination does not confer any right on the candidate for admission.
5. Candidates will not be allowed to carry ANY Modern Electronic Equipments, Pagers, Mobile Phones, Bluetooth, Markers, White Fluid, Calculator, Wireless sets, bits of paper, books / note etc. into the Examination Hall. The candidate (s) found in

possession of any of these items in the examination hall will be treated as unfair means and his / her result will not be declared.

6. Only **Non-Programmable** Calculators are allowed for "M.E. / M.Tech / M.Arch." examination only.
7. The candidates are not allowed to wear any type of watch in the examination hall / room.
8. The candidate should note that their candidature is strictly provisional. The mere fact that Admission Ticket has been issued and the candidate is allowed to appear for the examination shall not imply that the KEA has finally accepted his / her candidature.
9. Along with the Admission Ticket candidate has to carry any one valid Identity Card like College Identity Card or Bus Pass or Driving License or Passport or Aadhar Card or PAN Card or Voter ID.
10. The candidates have to follow the instructions given by the invigilators in the examination hall / room and should not argue with the invigilators or other staff involved in the examination duty at the examination centre. The candidates, who will not follow the instructions, will be treated as unfair means and his / her result will not be declared.
11. No candidate will be allowed to appear at the examination centre other than that allotted to him / her in the admission ticket.
12. The candidate should not carry more than two / three ball point pens (blue / black) to the examination hall and also they should not carry pencil with them to the examination hall.
13. Read the instructions given in the Admission Ticket.
14. Any candidate writes / shades anything other than the required entries on the OMR Answer Sheet, which may result in disclosing the candidate identity, or use of abusive language or employ any other unfair means, such as change of marking answers by scratching or using white fluid, such candidate's are liable for disqualification.
15. The candidate should use only Blue or black ink ball point pens.
