Post Graduate Medical / Dental Offline Seat Selection - 2017

(Only for Government seats in Government colleges & Government Quota seats in Private colleges)

**Eligibility:**

1. All the Candidates who have already verified their documents as per the eligibility conditions prescribed in Annexure -1 i.e., PGET Rules on various dates are only eligible to participate.
2. All candidates who have been either un-allotted or allotted in round 1 or 2 by holding the allotted seat can participate.
3. Those who have selected seat and cancelled / surrendered can also participate.
4. Registration for offline counselling is on the day of counselling itself as per schedule.
5. All those candidates participating in the counselling should deposit all the original documents with KEA if they have not done earlier (refer schedule). Those candidates appearing without the original documents for **any reason** will not be allowed to participate in the counselling.
6. *If any up gradation occurs and vacated seats left unfilled then they have **to pay penalty** as applicable.*

**Instructions to Candidates:**

1. All eligible & qualified candidates participating in the counselling should deposit all the original documents with KEA (If they have not done already) on 28<sup>th</sup> May 2017 for Medical & 29<sup>th</sup> May 2017 for Dental (Refer schedule).
2. Only the candidates are allowed in Counselling Hall. Parents, Children or Guardians should not enter the counselling Hall.
3. At the time of seat selection, the selected seat will be allotted seat only on producing the DD's for the required amount in favour of "Executive Director, KEA" payable at Bangalore. **Online payment or Cheques or Cash is not allowed.** Candidates are requested to carry DD of different denominations for the seat they are interested in.
4. The candidates who selects seat in this round if they surrender or cancel the seats in this round, forfeiture clause (refer schedule) will apply.
5. The seats remaining unallotted after completion of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Round of counselling are already decategorised. All candidates allowed for seat selection as per NBE rank.
6. Consequential vacancy which arises during the seat allotment will remain in the same category and offered to the next eligible candidates of respective category only.
7. After completion of the seat allotment if any reserved seat remains un-allotted then those seats will be de-categorised and offered to eligible candidates.
8. All the candidates are requested to co-operate with KEA for smooth conduct of counselling.

NOTE: The offline seat allotment is subject to final decision of the Hon'ble High Court in WP No. 22696-97 / 2017.
